



2010 Work in Review

- 2nd annual e-waste & media recycling event collected approximately 39,000 lbs of electronics, 782 lbs of household and industrial batteries, 210 lbs of incandescent holiday lights, and 172 lbs. of electronic media material. We collect toner & ink cartridges and cell phones year round.
- Produced 9 educational film & speaker presentations for the community.
- Continued Ojai Creek restoration efforts started in November 2009 and will continue next into Stewart Canyon Creek.
- Participated in 4th Earth Day and presented lots of educational information and activities.
- Collaborated for 3rd year with California Coastal Cleanup Day and collected trash & recycling from creeks for a day.
- Hosted for the 3rd year an Ojai Day bike valet, along with distributing educational information on alternative transportation.
- Contributed time and expertise to the city of Ojai's Grand Ave. 'Share the Road' effort. (And we think we're real close to getting bike racks at the Vons shopping center!)
- Continued plastic bag reduction efforts (coming soon signs for retailer parking lots and windows reminding us all to bring in our own bags).
- Continued efforts to get a new light ordinance passed with the city of Ojai and educate the community about light pollution.
- Produced 2nd Green Home & Building Tour and Home Show.
- Held food preservation workshops and vegetarian recipe swapping events
